

His Clay Wolfe/Port Essex Mysteries include *Wolfe Trap*, *Mind Trap*, *Mouse Trap*, *Cosmic Trap*, and now, *Pirate Trap*.

Cost will discuss the craft of writing and the evolution of *Pirate Trap* beginning at 6PM on Thursday, May 16. Join us in the Warren Community Room for what promises to be an enjoyable evening exploring the mystery of how a new book comes to life. Books will be available for purchase and signing. This program is free and open to the public.



Meet Neeps the tortoise!



Don't worry - the library has received its new 2024 Maine State Park pass! Patrons may check out the pass for three days; there is a \$5/day late fee. The pass must be checked out and returned in person and cannot be returned through the drop box.



The library also has a day pass to the Maine Discovery Museum in Bangor. It is valid for free, general admission for up to four patrons. The signed and dated form must be picked up from the library and presented at the museum.




